## A note from Mrs. Schmeltzer

Hello Edison Families,

We have been hard at work here assessing your students so they can show us what they know! Progress reports will be available for viewing on your Infinite Campus Parent Portal at 4:00 pm today.

Please note the scoring scale. We are now grading on a 3 point scale.

3 - Mastery: Your child has met the end of year target and demonstrated mastery of the standard.

2 - Developing: Your child has a basic understanding of the essential grade-level standard but needs teacher support to apply it or has not yet mastered the skill.

1-Beginning: Your child is not yet able to demonstrate an understanding of the essential grade-level standards.

At this time of the year 2 is expected for many standards that are still being taught and practiced. If your child is on track to meet end of year goals, they will currently have a 2 on their report card. If your child has mastered grade level standards, at this point in the year, they will have a 3.

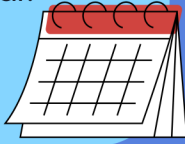

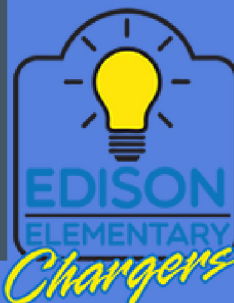
